Event Outcomes

154 Attendees

514 clinical conversations/referrals

2 patients referred into MSK services

7 hypertensive patients identified

4 high glucose levels identified

73 referrals to non-clinical services

55 complementary therapies provided

43 digital health support interventions

Outcomes for Attendees

96% of people attending said they had improved knowledge of health issues.

86% of people said they felt less isolated

100% said they had an improved knowledge of health services.

98% said they felt more confident in managing their health and wellbeing.
